



IT Security Consultant

This is a client facing role. Excellent interpersonal, technical, and writing skills are required. This position interfaces with external and internal stakeholders on a daily basis. This position will have primary responsibility to conduct professional security services engagements, including security and controls reviews, consultation with customers about security solutions alternatives and conduct security assessments in accordance with industry standards such as the PCI-DSS. Consultant must be comfortable working alone or with a team in a client's location and is responsible to ensure timely and quality deliverables to our clients.

The Consultant support and delivers information technology security programs for various clients, including developing, implementing, and maturing of security assessment services. - Conduct regular and ad-hoc review of IT security threats and vulnerabilities, and design and conduct compliance audits of IT security policy and procedures. Perform information security risk assessments and recommend improvement to reduce, contain and mitigate risks.
