



## **IT Security Consultant Manager/Director of Service Delivery**

The Consultant Manager directs information technology security services programs for various clients, including developing, implementing, and validating security systems.

Responsibilities include

- Provide guidance to IT consulting staff regarding all aspects of IT security and support client deliverables.
- Develop, implement, maintain, and monitor compliance of policies, procedures and associated plans for system security administration and user system access based on industry-standard best practices.
- Recommend and supervise implementation and operation of security systems and corresponding software, including firewalls, intrusion detection systems and anti-virus/spyware software. Ensure software fixes and security patches are applied and operated in accordance with established policies, procedures and standards.
- Monitor control systems and access levels, including periodic reviews of application access levels. Review and approve processes for managing end user accounts, permissions, and access rights.
- Conduct regular and adhoc review of IT security threats and vulnerabilities, and design and conduct compliance audits of IT security policy and procedures. Perform information security risk assessments and recommend improvement to reduce, contain and mitigate risks.

- Minimum of 5 years + experience IT Security Management
- BS degree in IT, CS or MIS
- Professional designations or accreditation in IT Security and audit, preferably Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA), Certified Information Security Manager (CISM), Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP), or Qualified Security Assessor (QSA and PA-QSA)
- Extensive Knowledge of security concepts and architecture, including operating systems, security and configuration, network security architecture and devices
- Knowledge of database security and configuration helpful

- An understanding of technical risk analysis and development of risk mitigation strategies
